

CONSTITUTION



TITLE: THE TITLE OF THE ORGANIZATION SHALL BE THE UNITED MARTIAL ALLIANCE, ALSO KNOWN AS U.M.A.

THE CONSTITUTION:

To promote the Practice and Sport of all Martial Arts.

To promote codes of safety in the practice and sport of all Martial Arts.

To promote the moral, mental, physical and social well being of all the Martial Arts Students, Members, Clubs, Affiliates, Federations and Governing Bodies.

To provide Students, Members, Clubs, Affiliates, Federations and Governing Bodies with support as may be available through their Membership of or with the U.M.A.

To provide, organise and run Seminars, Courses, Martial Arts Tournaments and Championships, Local, Regional, National and International Venues for both U.M.A. Members and Non U.M.A. Members.

To operate and maintain a register of current Students, Members, Clubs, Affiliates, Federations and Governing Bodies.

To raise, administer and expend funds in its discretion according to this constitution.

To arrange for the purchase, supply, sale and hire of all premises, equipment goods and services as may be required.

To act as an advisory body on matters appertaining to Martial Arts, through liaison with statutory and voluntary bodies, news media and other relevant third parties.

To co-operate with other Martial Arts related Clubs, Academies, Associations, Federations, and Governing Bodies having similar aims.

Membership shall be open to all and any Student, Instructor, Club, Association, Federation and Governing Body who subscribe to the purposes above and who shall abide by the constitution and bye-laws in force from time-to-time under the discretion of U.M.A.

Membership shall consist of Annual Individual, Club, Association Membership and Affiliation to U.M.A., and to any relevant Association, Federation and Governing Body of which U.M.A. are Affiliated to or Members of.

Insurance: All Students, Instructors, Assistant Instructors, Coach's, Members, Clubs and Affiliates shall be covered by Personal and Public Insurance that can be determined by and through U.M.A. if required.

Discipline: A Student, Instructor, Member, Club or Affiliate may be asked to leave or have an application or renewal of membership refused, suspended or dealt with in such a manner as may be determined by the U.M.A.

Membership: Annual U.M.A. Affiliation, Membership, License, Insurance and Receipt shall be issued on approved application and payment to the U.M.A.

The U.M.A. is a Non Interference, Non Political, Non Interference and Independently Democratically run Organisation.
